Pupil Premium is a specific allocation of funds, additional to main school funding, which the Government believes is the best way to address the current underlying inequalities between children who are in receipt of free school meals (FSM) and their peers. The Government believes that the allocation of Pupil Premium will tackle disadvantage by reaching the pupils who need it most,

Below are details of our Pupil Premium allocation for 2016-2017, how it was spent and the impact it has had on the children in our school.

In 2016-2017 we were allocated a total of **£38280** Pupil Premium funds.

Activity	Funding Allocated	Timeline	Impact
Contribution towards offsite visits and visitors to school	£3000	April 2016- April 2017	Curriculum is enriched and children have more experiences to base learning on.
Speech and Language Therapist to work with individuals and groups (including Talk to Learn) of children as well as develop staff skills one day a week	£10000	April 2016 – April 2017	Children’s speech and language development has improved at an early stage to help them develop in other areas.
Contribution towards extra TA support in order to deliver specific interventions such as ‘Switch On Reading/Writing’ and ‘Good to be me’	£1640	April 2016 – April 2017	Children make accelerated progress in order to narrow the gap in learning.
Contribution towards SEN Assistant working with Pupil premium/SEN children	£2640	April 2016 – April 2017	Children’s specific needs are being met.
Contribution towards additional TA to support children throughout FS and KS1 on specific targets in class	£10000	September 2016 – April 2017	Children’s specific needs are being met.
Teacher for 2 days per week for 1:1 work on Pupil Premium individual targets	£10000	September 2016 – April 2017	Children’s specific needs are being met.
Free After School Club for Pupil Premium children	£1000	April 2016 – April 2017	Children are given the opportunity to take part in all activities provided by the school.
