Week	UTW Shows an interest in animals and is beginning to understand that we need to take care of them Begins to ask questions about the natural world	Creative Paint skills – colour mixing and printing
1&2	Find out about bears — Where do they really live? (IWB pictures / film clips of their natural habitat) What country do they live in? (Look at the globe / world map) Sensory tuffspots to represent the grass, water, mud etc. in the story (explore with bare feet!)	Paint colour mixing — red, yellow and blue to make brown. Use the mixed paint to paint a bear using a fork or comb to add texture (like the bear's fur)
3&4	Construction — build a bridge for the goats using various media and on large and small scale e.g. box models, construction kits, crates, blocks and wooden planks (Think about how to make it strong enough, long enough, high enough to get the goats over the water)	Blotto trolls — fold and print technique and then add collage eyes, nose horns
5&6	Minibeast hunt outdoors (magnifying lenses) (esp. ladybirds) Visit wildlife area Caring for minibeasts in the garden — handling carefully; providing a home;	Painting on alternate media to paper — pebble painting to make a ladybird Minibeast prints — using model minibeasts and either print into playdough or print using paint onto paper
